



JUNIOR SAILING RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All Juniors and their guests are expected to behave with respect toward the instructors, supervisors, fellow Juniors and Club/Marina members and property at all times.
- All Juniors must wear a PFD while on the docks, on the boats or anywhere near the water.
- All Juniors are responsible for rigging and unrigging the boats as well as returning all equipment to proper storage.
- All equipment, which has been in contact with salt water, must be washed with fresh water and dried prior to storing.
- Running, shouting, fighting or roughhousing on the dock, in boats or anywhere else in club facilities or its surroundings is strictly prohibited. An unsafe behavior will bring immediate expulsion from the program for the rest of the season.
- All Juniors are responsible for their personal equipments.
- All Juniors must be on time for the scheduled activities.
- All Juniors will dress appropriately in comfortable clothes and soft-soled shoes (athletic or dock shoes) and will bring a change of clothes and a towel for each sailing session. Juniors wearing sandals, clogs, or other unsafe clothing will not be allowed on the boats.
- Juniors are not permitted in the clubhouse without an adult escort and at no time shall they be authorized to enter the bar on the second floor.
- Juniors are not authorized to bring motorized dinghies or tenders to the junior program area.
- Juniors will be responsible for any damage to boats (except normal wear and tear) and will be required to reimburse the club for such damage.
